

Decision of Institutional Certified Evaluation and Accreditation

Toyohashi University of Technology complies with the Standards for the Establishment of Universities and other relevant laws and regulations, and meets the Standards for Evaluation and Accreditation of Universities set by the National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation.

Good practices which have been identified by the review committee include:

- Developing human resources with international perspectives by providing the “overseas internship” program as an elective subject for its Master’s Course students
- Receiving international students in Master’s Program Given in English, an education and research program in which every lecture is delivered in English
- The MOT Company Internship, a human resource development program, to be regarded as distinctive
- The percentage of students who graduate within the required years of study is high among students having enrolled in the university in the third year, the number of whom accounts for about 80 percent of the graduates, with the results of the questionnaire surveys conducted on companies which hired the university’s graduates indicating that the university supplies a very large number of human resources that meet the needs of the business community
- Providing a better academic environment and responding to the needs of students, with the university’s library allowing students and academic and support staff to use its services 24 hours with necessary security measures in place
- Providing appropriate support for extracurricular activities by, for example, allocating a budget for promoting extracurricular activities, having academic staff assist with these activities by giving necessary supervision, and providing spaces dedicated to such activities as field tests and assembling work.

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
